

-Provides a definition of group treatment	
Advantages/Risks of Group Treatment "Any treatment modality-group therapy, individual therapy, family	
therapy, and medication-can yield poor results if administered by an unskilled or improperly trained therapist." (TIP 41 p 3)	
 □ Group therapy is not equivalent to individual therapy □ Group therapy is not equivalent to 12-Step program practices
